WHAT TO BRING

Bring all your bulky, hard-to-dispose-of household waste, scrap wood, yard debris, tires under 21 inches, unwanted furniture, and recyclable items such as metal, plastics 1 thru 7, bulky rigid plastics, and small appliances.

Reusable household items, such as furniture, kitchen tools, linens, clothes, and children's toys will be donated to the Community Warehouse.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

No food garbage, plaster, concrete, dirt, sheet rock, tires over 21 inches, or any material unacceptable at the landfill. No construction or landscaping materials.

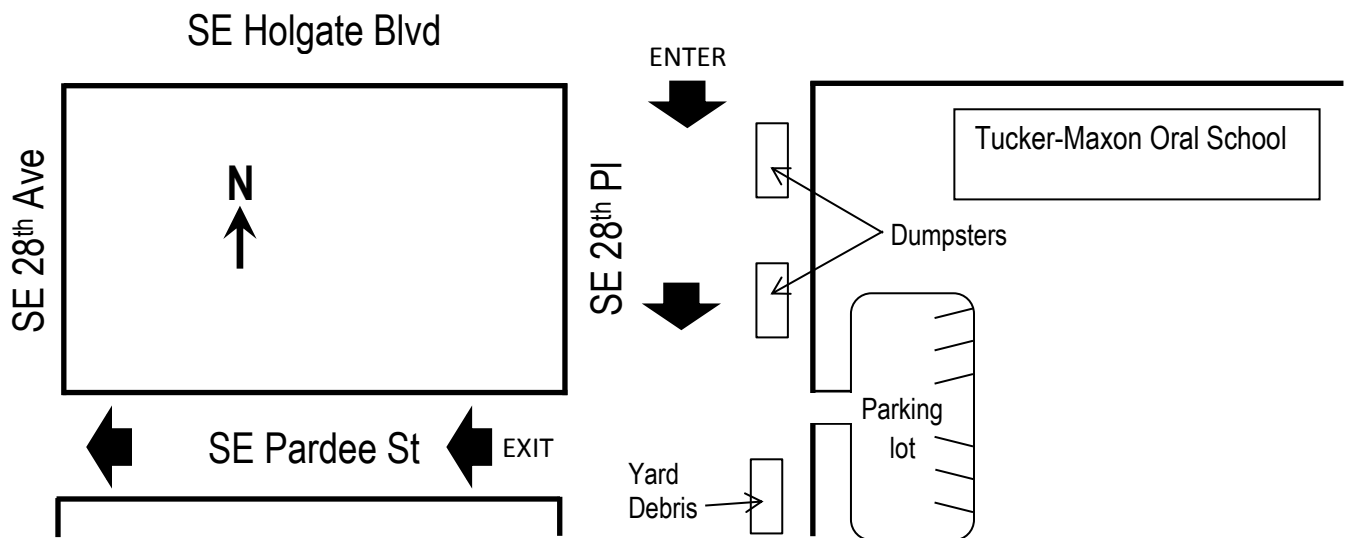
No hazardous materials (as defined by Metro): Paint, aerosol cans, liquids, batteries, pool chemicals, solvents, wood stain, antifreeze, thinners, poisons, toxins, herbicides, fluorescent light bulbs (CFL), et cetera. Paint cans with lids off and dried paint are okay.

No air conditioners, freezers, refrigerators, compressors, or other items containing Freon.

COST

\$10 small load (sedan, small station wagon) • **\$20** medium load (pickup) • **\$30** large load (large truck or van)

Proceeds go towards neighborhood association projects that help create more livable communities for us all. Fees are less than the minimums at the landfill, and the location more convenient! Neighbors are encouraged to use curbside recycling for appropriate items prior to the event.
